

Home Learning at MMI

24th March 2020

Dear Whanau,

The school will close for the holidays from the 30th March until the 14th April. As we want to continue to provide meaningful learning opportunities for our students, teachers will be providing a range of educational activities for students while they are at home.

- From Tuesday the 24th of March until Friday the 27th staff will be setting up for online learning and checking that your child is set up ready to go.
- If you do not have a device, devices can be collected from school office today and tomorrow.
- If you do not have internet access, paper packs can also be collected from the school office, or posted out.
- All students will need to know their school email and password to allow access to lessons provided. If your child does not have this, please contact your child's classroom teacher.
- **Google Classroom** - will be set up as the main sharing platform for daily/weekly resources. If students are not currently set up on Google Classroom, teachers will share a class code or email students to ensure all have joined their Google Classroom (Information below). Teachers will create the assignment or make an announcement for students. Teachers can view and monitor student work during this process. Students will be able to work independently and on collaborative projects while at home.
- **[Education Perfect](#)** - is an online learning platform that has a range of resources across the curriculum at different levels. Teachers will be able to set tasks for students to complete and can monitor student achievement. Each of these tasks will be emailed to students and also shared through Google Classroom. There is also a vast amount of options for students to choose tasks from Education Perfect that they are interested in exploring on their own.
- Teachers will be available online from 9.00am - 11.00am and 1.00pm - 3.00pm, starting on the 15th April. Students will be able to make contact and check in with their learning.

- **Email** - any questions or communication can take place through teachers email.
- **Daily Fitness and Wellbeing** - we suggest that you encourage creative ways that your child can be active in and around the home.
- **Read** - daily reading is recommended to provide another avenue for learning and entertainment.

When your child is at home, time needs to be given for learning. We are relying on your support. Students will need to get into the routine to check their email and google classroom regularly to keep up with work that has been set by their classroom teacher. We do not expect you to be the teacher. Be positive and encouraging re online learning.

Instructions for Students/Parents if students have not been set up on Google Classroom or Education Perfect:

1. **Students need to know their school google email and password.** Eg. 2020ibear@mtint.school.nz If students do not know their email or password parents need to email their classroom teacher for this.
2. **Google Classroom:**
To set up on **Google Classroom** - you will need to use the Class Code or join via email link that your teacher has sent you. Click on this link or join class and enter the code to have access to Google Classroom.
3. On Google Classroom there will be a link for **Education Perfect** - Go to the login page and go to 'create an account using access code'.
 - Your class code is
 - Click on the link to create your account through using the class code.
 - Put in the code and this will take you to your Education Perfect class.
 - You will have to add your first name, last name and school email, push enter.
 - Once you have completed this you will need to go to your school gmail to activate your account. This will direct you to Education Perfect.
 - Your username is your school email and your password is your first name all in lowercase.

- You will need to select a few subject areas you are interested in and click '**DONE, Start Learning**'.

You have now been successfully logged into Education Perfect. You can click on '**Tasks and Assessments**' at the top of the page to see tasks assigned to you by your teacher.

When you receive a new task from Education Perfect, these will come up on your google classroom and will also be emailed to you.
